

C.A.R.S Alphabet Contest

- 1. This Orbis Vocum trophy is awarded annually to paid-up members of the society.
- 2. The trophy will be presented to the winner at the AGM normally held in October.

Objectives

- 1. To form the letters of the alphabet by taking the initial letter of the actual QTH of the station worked.
- 2. The member of the society with the most letters of the alphabet completed will be the winner.
- 3. In the event of a tie, the trophy will be shared.

Rules

- 1. All contacts to be made between 0000 GMT 1st January and 2359 31st July in the calendar year.
- 2. All contacts to be made on frequencies authorized to the transmitting station or for short wave listeners any stations heard on any authorized amateur radio frequencies
- 3. All contacts to be made from the main station address
- 4. Contacts via repeaters are not acceptable.
- 5. Claim sheets to be submitted to (see contact list) as soon as possible by the 31st July of the calendar year. Claim sheets are encouraged on a monthly basis and these contacts will count towards the final award.
- 6. Claim sheets are available on the society's website
- 7. Claims should be submitted to the Secretary.
