Rules for Annual G4ZMC Portable Competition Memorial Trophy

1. The club will organise portable events from suitable locations in the local area.
2. The aim is to make as many contacts as you can between 1930 & 2130 local time.
3. Any amateur bands and any mode can be used according to a rota set out. This rota will set out allocated times for short sessions on 3.5, 7, 14, 18 & 144 MHz in turn for each group/individual taking part. Participants can operate on the other bands outside these times.
4. Members can choose to forego their allocated sessions if they so choose but should inform the organiser of their intention.
5. Contacts via repeaters, satellites or the Internet are not permitted.
6. The scoring system is based on multipliers which favour the less used amateur bands.
7. Each contact builds up a score based on the multiplier

8. The aim is to encourage members to use the less used bands during the sessions.
9. Log sheets will be provided and participants are asked to complete them and hand in to the organiser at the end of the session.
10. The winner will be that person who makes the highest score from the best 2 evenings' contacts.
11. The G4ZMC trophy will normally be presented to the winner(s) at the Annual General Meeting.
